

LGHS GRADUATION 2019

Once again, LGHS is offering the families of our graduating seniors reserved seating for the ceremony. The LGHS front lawn will be closed to the public throughout the day, and family members will be assigned seating. No more saving seats or arriving early– all families will now have an equal opportunity to view their student’s graduation. The details of our updated seating arrangements are included in this email.

Seating Selection Assigned Randomly

- Each family with a graduating senior may request up to six (6) seats for the ceremony.
- The seating request, [available on line](#), will open from April 24-May 8
- Seating for those who are disabled will be available; please indicate your needs on the online form.
- Once assigned, tickets will be mailed to each family during the week of May 27th. The tickets will be mailed to the primary address listed in our Aeries database. Tickets will not be released to your student. The seating map will be posted on the LGHS website.
- **NOTE:**
 - Timing of the request does not impact assignment; this will be done randomly after the close of on-line submissions.
 - Only one set of six tickets is offered to each family regardless of how many graduates are in the ceremony, and regardless whether the student has an extended family.
 - Finally, families may request more than 6 tickets; the school will attempt to honor that request if seating is available, however not all members may end up sitting together.

Graduation Day Process

- The front lawn will be closed to the public during the day for set up, practice, and the post-practice meeting with graduating seniors. No one will be permitted in the seating area during this preparation time.
- The front lawn will open for ticket holders at 4:00pm. **Bring tickets with you.**
- Ushers will be available to help you locate seats.
- Areas of the front lawn not available for reserved seating will be open at 5:00 pm as standing room only
- Limited parking is available for disabled participants along Chicago Avenue, and on High School Court.
- Parking is available in the LGHS student lots, however they fill up quickly; attendees should consider parking away from campus and walking to the ceremony.
- Traffic along Main Street will not be closed during the ceremony, however it will be very slow. Allow plenty of time to arrive at the ceremony.
