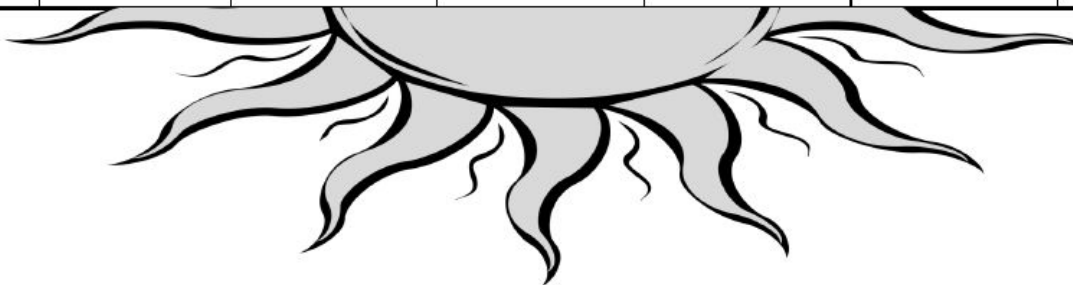

GRADUATION REHEARSAL AND CEREMONY - Friday, June 7, 2019

Congratulations to the Graduating Class of 2019! The commencement ceremony at LGHS is a very special occasion to honor the hard work of each senior as well as the community of supporters who have helped each of you earn your high school diploma – family, friends, teammates, coaches, teachers, and staff, among others. The ceremony is a dignified occasion and has been carefully prepared by faculty members who have supported you and remain committed to your success. Please read the following information so that you will be able to participate fully and return honor to all of those who have supported your journey along the way.

ATTENDANCE IS REQUIRED AT GRADUATION REHEARSAL!

1. In order to participate in the commencement exercises, you **MUST BE PRESENT AT THE MANDATORY 8:45 A.M. REHEARSAL ON FRIDAY, JUNE 7. Seniors not present at this rehearsal will not be allowed to participate in the evening ceremony.** The rehearsal will be completed at approximately 12:00 noon. **No one will be excused prior to the end of rehearsal.**
2. Marching assignments will be posted Tuesday, June 4, at Senior Fun Day. After Tuesday, the list will be posted in the main hallway. If you are unable to check assignments before leaving school on Thursday, please plan on arriving to school early Friday to view your room assignment. All participating graduates will be assigned to rooms in the main building and classroom building for the purposes of taking roll, arranging the marching order, checking of appropriate attire, and the issuing of diplomas. Graduates must report to their assigned classrooms **by 8:45 a.m. on the morning of practice and by 5:30 p.m. on the night of graduation.** Guests are not allowed in these rooms.
3. Anyone under the **influence of alcohol or other drugs** before or during the ceremony **will not be allowed to participate.**
4. **Seniors must have paid in full all current financial obligations prior to 12:30 p.m. on June 4th.** This means all fines paid and all textbooks, library books and uniforms returned. If you fail to meet this obligation, **you will not receive your diploma until your fines are paid.** You can settle your account the following Monday, June 11 after graduation if you miss the deadline.

Rehearsal day can be very warm. ***Please arrive on time (by 8:45 am) so we can start the rehearsal on time and beat the heat!***

DRESSING FOR THE GRADUATION CEREMONY

1. Gowns must be pressed (with a warm, not hot iron). The tassel is worn to the right of the cap and remains there. Caps should be placed on the head so that the mortar board is level, not tilted back. No additional decorations or adornments may be worn.

2. **DO NOT CHEW GUM!**

3. **INFORMATION FOR GIRLS:**

1. Girls should wear a simple, lightweight dress without a high neckline which would show above the collar.
2. Beach flip flops, bare feet, slippers, or tennis shoes are **not acceptable footwear**.
3. It is a good idea to bring safety pins (and maybe even bobby pins to hold your cap in place!) for emergencies.
4. **Flowers or other adornments of the cap or gown are not allowed.**

4. **INFORMATION FOR BOYS**

1. Boys are to wear dress shirts and a necktie. Boys without neckties will not be allowed to participate.
2. Beach flip flops, bare feet, slippers, or tennis shoes are **not acceptable footwear**.
3. It is customary for the boys to remove their caps during the playing of the national anthem.
4. **Adornments of the cap or gown are not allowed.**

Senior Class Expectations (A reminder -- please follow all school rules.)

Observe LGHS Rules... All LGHS rules apply to students while on campus and during school-sponsored activities, including throughout Senior Week. In addition to receiving penalties, such as suspension, students involved in any of the following activities may not participate in senior activities, including marching with their class during the graduation ceremony:

- **Students involved in the possession, sale, transfer, or use of drugs or alcohol;**
- **Students who are found to be under the influence of drugs or alcohol;**
- **Students involved in any pranks, described as "actions that are significantly disruptive to educational programs."**
